What is sexting?

Sexting consists of sending or getting sexual explicit or suggestive images, messages, or videos through the Internet via digital devices.

WHAT IS THE PROJECT OBJECTIVE?

The project raises awareness about the risks of sexting and encourages intergenerational discussion about sexting. Through its educational products it creates an open and innovative educational methodology for explaining digital sex education to students aged 10-19, their parents and teachers. The project is funded by Erasmus+ and implemented by organisations from Czech Republic, Cyprus, Italy, Portugal, Romania, and Slovenia.



WHO IS THE PROJECT FOR?

The project educational products are designed to help:

- <u>students</u> aged 10-19 to understand sexting, how to avoid its risks, and how to seek help when needed
- parents to better understand and support their children if
 sexting occurs and has negative consequences
- <u>teachers</u> to <u>communicate</u> with their students about digital sex education good practices and <u>provide support</u> when needed



WHAT DOES THE PROJECT PRODUCE?

The project developed educational materials:

- 1. <u>Context analysis report</u> on situation of sexting among students 10-19 years-old in 6 countries
- 2. <u>Teaching handbook & e-learning platform</u> with materials and training guidance for students, teachers, and parents
- 3. In-school pilot courses in 6 countries
- 4. <u>Guidelines</u> on implementation of <u>digital sex education courses</u>
